## Step-by-Step Guide:

### 1. Enable Developer Mode on Your Android Phone:

- Open **Settings** on your Android phone.
- Navigate to **System** or **About Phone**.
- Tap **Build Number** multiple times until a message confirms Developer Mode is enabled.

### 2. Open the Wear OS App:

- Launch the **Wear OS by Google** app on your connected Android device.

### 3. Access the Menu:

- Tap the **three dots** icon in the top-right corner of the app screen.

### 4. Capture the Screenshot:

- In the menu, select the **Screenshot** option or go through **Developer Options**.
- Your Moto 360 display will be captured and saved.
